2 AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, AMENDING CHAPTER 2.36 OF THE RIVERSIDE MUNICIPAL CODE, 3 AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO MAKE INTERIM CHANGES TO THE NUMBER AND/OR CLASSIFICATION OF POSITIONS WITHIN 4 THE ADOPTED FISCAL YEAR BUDGET 5 The City Council of the City of Riverside does ordain as follows: 6 Section 1: Chapter 2.36 Personnel System Table of Contents is amended as follows: 7 "PERSONNEL SYSTEM 8 Sections: 9 2.36.010 Purpose of chapter. 10 11 2.36.140 Changes In Number and Classification of Positions." 12 Section 2: Section 2.36.140 is added to the Riverside Municipal Code as follows: 13 "Section 2.36.140 Changes In Number and Classification of Positions. 14 The City Manager shall have the authority to increase or decrease the number of 15 positions and/or substitute the classification of those positions, so long as the total annual cost 16 for the resulting positions does not exceed the approved budget for the current fiscal year(s). 17 Any substitution of a classification shall be limited to existing classifications previously created 18 by City Council." 19 The City Council has reviewed the matter and, based upon the facts and Section 3: 20 information contained in the staff reports, administrative record, and written and oral testimony, 21 hereby finds that this ordinance is not subject to CEQA pursuant to Sections 15060(c)(2), 22 15060(c)(3) and/or 15061(b)(3) of the State CEQA Guidelines, California Code of Regulations, Title 23 14, Chapter 3, in that it will not result in a direct or reasonably foreseeable indirect physical change 24 in the environment nor have a significant impact on the environment. 25 The City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this ordinance and cause Section 4: 26 publication once in a newspaper of general circulation in accordance with Section 414 of the Charter 27 of the City of Riverside. This ordinance shall become effective on the 30th day after the date of its 28 adoption.
