SUBJECT: REJECT ALL BIDS RECEIVED IN RESPONSE TO BID NO. 7471 TO FURNISH AND INSTALL VARIOUS TYPES OF EMERGENCY EQUIPMENT ON SIX POLICE INTERCEPTOR SUV PURSUIT VEHICLES

ISSUES:

Reject all bids received in response to Bid No. 7471 to furnish and install various types of emergency equipment on six (6) Police Interceptor SUV Pursuit vehicles.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

That the City Council reject the proposals received in response to Bid No. 7471 to furnish and install various types of emergency equipment on six (6) Police Interceptor SUV Pursuit vehicles.

DISCUSSION:

On March 30, 2017, the City of Riverside posted Bid No. 7471 to furnish and install various types of emergency equipment on six (6) Police Interceptor SUV Pursuit vehicles. On April 18, 2017, the City received four responses to the Bid. After review of the Bid responses it was determined, that due to ambiguity in the bid standard bid language and subsequent confusion among the bidders, to allow all bidders to be treated equally, all bid should be rejected.

The Purchasing Services Manager concurs with the recommendation above.
