# FIRST AMENDMENT TO PROFESSIONAL CONSULTANT SERVICES AGREEMENT

THIS FIRST AMENDMENT TO PROFESSIONAL CONSULTANT SERVICES AGREEMENT ("First Amendment") is made and entered into this \_\_\_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_\_, 2017, by and between the CITY OF RIVERSIDE, a California charter city and municipal corporation ("City"), and INDUSTRIAL EVOLUTION, INC., an Arizona corporation authorized to do business in California ("Consultant"), with respect to the following facts:

#### RECITALS

WHEREAS, on July 18, 2016, City and Consultant entered into that certain Professional Consultant Services Agreement, in conjunction with PI System Enterprise Support Services ("Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, City is satisfied with the performance of Consultant; and

WHEREAS, Consultant was asked to perform additional duties outside the original scope of services for PI System Enterprise Support Services; and

WHEREAS, City and Consultant desire to extend the term of the contract for one additional year, to July 18, 2018; and

WHEREAS, City and Consultant desire to increase the contract amount to Seven Hundred Twenty-Four Thousand Dollars (\$724,000).

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing recitals which are incorporated herein by this reference, City and Consultant agree as follows:

- 1. The term of the Agreement is hereby extended by one additional year, to July 18, 2018.
- 2. The Scope of Services is amended with the addition of the services described in Exhibit "A-1," attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.
- 3. Section 3. "Compensation/Payment" is hereby amended by increasing the contract amount to Seven Hundred Twenty-Four Thousand Dollars (\$724,000) for the additional services, as set forth in Exhibit "B-1," attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.
- 4. All other terms and conditions of the Agreement between the parties which are not inconsistent with the terms of this First Amendment, shall remain in full force and effect as if fully set forth herein.



#### 1.0 Purpose

This document is a commercial proposal from Industrial Evolution to the City of Riverside that outlines our scope of work and terms for providing resources for the Pi System enterprise architecture design, validation, implementation, and training to support City of Riverside operations.

- Develop solutions to leverage PI System artifacts beyond the initial workshop sessions based on project needs. This includes dashboards in addition to the initial scoped displays.
- Gather business unit requirements (analytical, reporting, notifications) and enable through best practice design/setup of the OSIsoft ecosystem components: PI Asset Framework, PI Event Frames, PI Analytics, PI ProcessBook/PI Coresight, PI DataLink, PI Manual Logger, PI Notifications.
- Create PI AF builder load file spreadsheets under direction of OSIsoft during the first workshop. This is based on RPU GIS and Asset Management instances. This will be used to load AF elements and attributes during first workshop.
