A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, (1) APPROVING AN APPLICATION AND AGREEMENT OF DEPARTMENT THE WITH U.S. INTERIOR, BUREAU OF RECLAMATION, FOR A 2017 WATERSMART GRANT; (2) AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE ALL NECESSARY DOCUMENTS RELATED TO SUCH GRANT; (3) AUTHORIZING ACCEPTANCE OF SUCH GRANT FUNDS; (4) AGREEING TO COMMIT UP TO \$74,333 IN MATCHING FUNDS; AND (5) VERIFYING THAT THE CITY WILL WORK TO MEET ESTABLISHED DEADLINES FOR ENTERING INTO A GRANT OR COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, the City of Riverside ("City"), through its Department of Public Utilities ("RPU"), is seeking grant funding for a Water Loss Minimization Project ("Project") using data analytics to assist in identifying losses caused by meter decay and inaccurate water meter measurement and recording; and

WHEREAS, the proposed Project will integrate advanced data analytics across all RPU meters (65,000 metered connections both residential and commercial) to better understand the overall health of RPU's metering system; and

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of the Interior, Bureau of Reclamation's ("Reclamation") 2017 WaterSMART (Sustain and Manage America's Resources for Tomorrow) Program establishes a framework to provide Federal leadership and assistance for using water efficiently, integrating water and energy policies to support the sustainable use of all natural resources, and coordinating the water conservation activities of various Interior bureaus and offices; and

WHEREAS, through WaterSMART Grants, Reclamation provides financial assistance to water managers for projects that seek to conserve and use water more efficiently, increase the use of renewable energy and improve energy efficiency, benefit threatened and endangered species, investigate and develop water marketing strategies, prevent any water related-related crisis, or otherwise contribute to water supply sustainability in the Western United States; and

WHEREAS, concurrent with this resolution, the City is submitting a grant application to Reclamation for a 2017 WaterSMART grant for the Project; and

WHEREAS, if awarded the grant, the City agrees to pay provide matching funds in the amount of the grant.

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NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Riverside, 2 California, as follows:

Section 1. That the City Manager of the City of Riverside, or his designee, on behalf of the City of Riverside, is authorized to submit an application to and accept funds for a 2017 WaterSMART grant totaling \$74,332 from the U.S. Department of the Interior, Bureau of Reclamation for a Water Loss Minimization Project (Project).

Section 2. That the City Manager of the City of Riverside, or his designee, is authorized to execute the necessary grant documents, including any agreements.

Section 3. That the City Council authorize acceptance of Reclamation grant funds in an account to be assigned by the City's Finance Division for appropriate revenues and expenditures.

That the City agrees to match and otherwise expend the amount of the grant Section 4. funds, or up to \$74,333, for the Project.

Section 5: That the City will work with Reclamation to meet established deadlines for entering into a grant or cooperative agreement.
