# **PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE**

On May 17, 2017, the Public Safety Committee received an update on fireworks education and enforcement activities and unanimously voted to recommend that the update be forwarded to the City Council.

### **BACKGROUND**

- 1. The manufacturing, possession, storage, use and handling of fireworks is prohibited in the City of Riverside under Section 16.32.100 of the Riverside Municipal Code (RMC).
- 2. Fire and Police to work together July 1st July 4th to provide public outreach and fireworks patrol enforcement teams throughout the City.

### **RMC ADDITIONS**

- 1. RMC Chapter 1.18, Section 1.18.040 Penalties: Admin Citation in the amount of \$1,000.
- 2. RMC Chapter 16.32, Section 104.1.1 Citations: Fire code official and his or her designee are authorized to issue a citation.
- 3. RMC Chapter 16.32, Section 16.32.080 Assistance from Other Agencies: Authority to render assistance with investigation of fires/enforcement when requested to do so.

## FIREWORKS ACTION PLAN

- 1. RFD, RPD and Riverside TV to develop a Public Service Announcement (PSA) on fireworks dangers.
- 2. "Fireworks are Illegal" fliers, signs and inserts distributed throughout the City.
- 3. RFD and RPD will use social media outlets to identify illegal fireworks sales activity.

### FIREWORKS ACTION PLAN

- 4. Partnership between RFD and RPD to issue administrative citations for fireworks violations.
- 5. City Marketing staff to develop handouts for distribution to schools via RPD School Resource Officers.
- 6. RFD and RPD staff will continue to attend community events to provide education on dangers associated with fireworks.

- 7. RFD and RPD will bring in additional staffing the evening of July 4<sup>th</sup>.
- 8. Fire management staff will be on duty and available on-call for emergencies.
