SUBJECT: CANVASS OF JUNE 6, 2017, GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION

ISSUE:

With completion of the canvass of the June 6, 2017, election, the City Council must certify the results of the election for Wards 2, 4, and 6.

RECOMMENDATION:

That the City Council adopt the attached resolution reciting the results of the general municipal election held on June 6, 2017, and declaring the results.

BACKGROUND:

Per Elections Code Section 10262, on or before June 30, 2017, the Registrar of Voters will complete the canvass of returns for the General Municipal Election conducted on June 6, 2017, for the purpose of electing Councilmembers for Wards 2, 4, and 6. The Statement of Results will be distributed upon receipt by the City Clerk.

The City Clerk anticipates the final Statement of Results to reflect the same outcomes as preliminary tallies.

The following candidates appeared on the ballot:

Ward 2

Andy Melendrez
Kevin M. Dawson
Jon Scott Harris

Ward 4

Chuck Conder
Paul Davis

Ward 6

Jim Perry
Rafael Elizalde

Voters elected Andy Melendrez (Ward 2), Chuck Conder (Ward 4), and Jim Perry (Ward 6) for full four-year terms through June 2021. As all successful candidates received a majority of votes cast, these election results do not trigger a run-off election for November 2017.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The City Clerk included estimated charges for the June 6, 2017, regular municipal election of \$163,500 in the Fiscal Year 2017-18 Budget.
