

1 RESOLUTION NO.

2 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
3 RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, RECITING THE FACT OF THE
4 GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION HELD IN SAID CITY ON
5 THE 6TH DAY OF JUNE, 2017, DECLARING THE RESULTS
6 THEREOF AND SETTING FORTH SUCH OTHER MATTERS AS
7 ARE PROVIDED BY LAW.

8 WHEREAS, a General Municipal Election was held and conducted in the City of
9 Riverside on the 6th day of June, 2017, as required by law for the purpose of electing members
10 of the City Council for Wards 2, 4 and 6; and

11 WHEREAS, notice of said election was duly and regularly given in the time, form and
12 manner as provided by law; voting precincts were properly established; election officers were
13 appointed and in all respects said election was held and the returns made and declared in the
14 time, form, and manner as required by the provisions of the Charter of the City of Riverside and
15 the Elections Code of the State of California for the holding of elections in the City of Riverside;
16 and

17 WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 23136 adopted on the 24th day of January, 2017,
18 the appropriate County official canvassed the returns of said election and has certified the results
19 to this City Council and said results are received, attached, and made a part hereof as Exhibit
20 "A".

21 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Riverside, as
22 follows:

23 Section 1: That there were ten (10) voting precincts in the Second Ward; eleven (11)
24 voting precincts in the Fourth Ward; and (10) voting precincts in the Sixth Ward.

25 Section 2: That said General Municipal election was held for the purpose of electing
26 three (3) members of the City Council of the City of Riverside from Wards 2, 4, and 6 of the City
27 of Riverside as established by the City Council.

28 Section 3: That all voter ballots were cast by mail in the City of Riverside; that the whole
number of votes cast in the Second Ward in the City of Riverside was 4,341; that the whole
number of votes cast in the Fourth Ward in the City of Riverside was 5,673; and that the whole

1 number of votes cast in the Sixth Ward in the City was 3,909.

2 Section 4: That the names of the persons voted for at said election and the office which
3 each person was voted for are as follows:

4 CITY COUNCIL, WARD 2:

5 ANDY MELENDREZ for Member of the City Council

6 KEVIN M. DAWSON for Member of the City Council

7 JON SCOTT HARRIS for Member of the City Council

8 CITY COUNCIL, WARD 4:

9 CHUCK CONDER for Member of the City Council

10 PAUL DAVIS for Member of the City Council

11 CITY COUNCIL, WARD 6:

12 JIM PERRY for Member of the City Council

13 RAFAEL ELIZALDE for Member of the City Council

14 That the number of votes given at each precinct and the number of votes given in the City
15 to each of said persons above named for the respective offices for which said persons were
16 candidates are listed on the attached Exhibit "A".

17 Section 5: That the City Council does declare and determine that Andy Melendrez was
18 elected as a member of the City Council from the Second Ward of said City to serve for the full
19 term of four years.

20 Section 6: That the City Council does declare and determine that Chuck Conder was
21 elected as a member of the City Council from the Fourth Ward of said City to serve for the full
22 term of four years.

23 Section 7: That the City Council does declare and determine that Jim Perry was elected
24 as a member of the City Council from the Sixth Ward of said City to serve for the full term of
25 four years.

26 Section 8: That the City Clerk shall enter on the records of the City Council of said City
27 a statement of the results of the General Municipal election held on June 6, 2017, showing:

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- 1 (1) The whole number of votes cast in the Second, Fourth, and Sixth Wards of said
2 City;
3 (2) The names of the persons voted for;
4 (3) The office each person was voted for;
5 (4) The number of votes given at each precinct to each of said persons; and
6 (5) The number of votes given in the Second, Fourth, and Sixth Wards of said City to
7 each of person running for member of City Council.

8 Section 9: That pursuant to Section 400 of the Riverside City Charter, on or before
9 July 11, 2017, the City Clerk shall deliver to the person so elected, a Certificate of Election
10 signed by her and duly authenticated; that she shall also administer to each person elected, the
11 Oath of Office prescribed in the State Constitution of the State of California and shall have them
12 subscribe thereto and file the same in her office; whereupon, said persons so elected shall be
13 inducted in to the office to which they have been elected.
