## RESOLUTION NO.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, (1) AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO AWARD WORKS OF PUBLIC CONSTRUCTION TO THE LOWEST RESPONSIVE AND RESPONSIBLE BIDDER FOR CONSTRUCTION NOT TO EXCEED \$500,000 FOR PROJECTS ADVERTISED FOR BID UNDER THE WATER DIVISION PAVING PANEL; AND (2) DIRECTING CITY MANAGER TO SEEK BOARD APPROVAL FOR ADDITIONS TO THE WATER DIVISION PAVING PANEL

WHEREAS, the Electric and Water Divisions of the Public Utilities Department ("RPU") generally award contracts to outside forces, after a formal competitive bidding process, to perform public works construction; and

WHEREAS, City Charter section 1109 provides that the City Council may, by at least five affirmative votes, waive the formal bidding requirements for projects for the construction and/or improvement; and

WHEREAS, on December 10, 2010, the City Council adopted Resolution 22132, waiving the formal bidding requirements of Section 1109, establishing a Contractors' Panel for paving projects for the Water Division (the "Water Division Paving Panel"), and authorizing the City Manager to execute master agreements with each panel member and to add contractors to the panel from time to time; and

WHEREAS, the criteria established for use of the panels is when: (1) City forces do not have the ability (expertise) or the capacity (resources) to construct the project within the time frame required; and 2) the project cost is under \$500,000; and

WHEREAS, Public Utilities' Water division lacks in-house capacity and resources to timely perform all of the paving related to the public works construction needed to meet the City's goals of improving reliability of water service and replacing aging infrastructure as well as quickly responding to customer demands for water service for residential, commercial and industrial development; and

WHEREAS, the panels use accelerated competitive bidding to pre-qualified contractors that have executed a Master Agreement that allow bids to be solicited, submitted, evaluated and the construction project to be awarded to the lowest responsible and responsive bidder within as little as

1	fifteen days as compared to the fifty-three days, minimum, required for formal competitive bidding;

3	WHEREAS, the Water Division Paving Panel has been successful in promoting the timely			
4	completion of water projects throughout the City and staff recommends continuing the use of the			
5	Water Division Paving Panel for the reasons set forth herein; and			
6	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Riverside,			
7	California, based upon the reasons set forth herein and in the accompanying staff report and			
8	presentation, as follows:			
9	Section 1: The City Manager, or his designee, is authorized to issue purchase orders for the			
10	award of works of public construction to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder for			
11	construction not to exceed \$500,000 for projects advertised for bid under the Water Division Paving			
12	Panel, if the expenditure has been approved by either the Board of Public Utilities or the City			
13	Council, as applicable;			
14	Section 2: Direct the City Manager to seek Board approval for add qualified contractors to			
15	the Water Division Paving Panel.
