BACKGROUND

- 1. Public Works may establish axle restrictions to prohibit truck traffic on certain segments of arterial streets.
- 2. Such restrictions help to move truck traffic from arterials onto local freeways to reduce wear and tear of roadways, reduce noise and emissions, and improve safety.
- 3. Deliveries or Picking Up of materials not impacted within the restricted zones.

TYPES OF RESTRICTIONS

1. Weight Limit:

- a. Restricts truck activity based upon gross vehicle weight rating(GVWR); and
- b. Typical for use on local and collector roadways with lower traffic volumes and thinner asphalt section.

2. Axle Restriction:

- a. Prohibits use by trucks exceeding a specific number of axles; and
- b. Utilized for select arterial roadways to limit larger, heavier trucks.

APPLICATIONS FOR AXLE RESTRICTIONS

Axle restrictions control large/heavy truck use on arterial streets impacted by:

- a. Excessive damage to asphalt; and/or
- b. Traffic or safety concerns
- c. Cut-through traffic to bypass freeway congestion
- d. Noise (Jake brake) and Emissions

AXLE RESTRICTIONS

- 1. Existing 3-Axle restriction on Main Street between Columbia Avenue and SR-60.
- 2. **Recommended -** Alessandro Boulevard/Central Avenue between Trautwein Road and SR-91
- 3. **Recommended -** Van Buren Boulevard between Lincoln Avenue and Citrus Heights Drive

ENFORCEMENT

- 1. Riverside Police Department (RPD) recommends the use of Axle Restrictions on Arterial Streets as it provide probable cause to stop trucks.
- 2. May utilize mobile truck scale equipment to also assess weight and weight distribution.
- 3. RPD Officers continue to monitor and enforce to ensure compliance.
