2	A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE,
3	CALIFORNIA, PROVIDING FOR THE SUMMARY VACATION (CASE NO. P17-0423) OF APPROXIMATELY 2,044 SQUARE FEET OF ALLEY
4 5	LOCATED MID-BLOCK BETWEEN MARKET STREET AND THE MAIN STREET PEDESTRIAN MALL, IN THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA.
6 7	WHEREAS, the City of Riverside proposes to vacate an approximately 2,044 square foot
8	portion of the alley that connects Mission Inn Avenue and Sixth Street, between Market Street
0 9	and the Main Street Pedestrian Mall, in the City of Riverside, California, as described and
-	depicted in Exhibit "A", attached hereto and incorporated by reference (hereinafter "the
10	Property"); and
11	WHEREAS, the Property is excess right-of-way and is not required for street or highway
12	purposes; and
13	WHEREAS, the adjoining properties and public service easements will not be affected by
14	the vacation of the Property; and
15	WHEREAS, the Property has been used for private parking stalls since 1998, does not
16	provide access to any parcels and no funds have been expended by the City over the last five (5)
17	years; and
18	WHEREAS, Section 8334 of the Streets and Highways Code provides that the legislative
19	body of a local agency may summarily vacate the Property that is excess right-of-way and not
20	required for street or highway purposes; and
21	WHEREAS, the City Council wishes to proceed under the provisions of Section 8330, et
22	seq. of the Street and Highways Code to summarily vacate the Property.
23	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Riverside,
24	California, as follows:
25	Section 1: The vacation of the Property is undertaken pursuant to the provisions of
26	Chapter 4 (commencing with Section 8330) of Part 3 of the Streets and Highways Code of the
27	State of California.

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Section 2: The City Council finds and determines as follows:

(a) The Property is excess right-of-way and is not required for street or
highway purposes.

4 (b) The vacation of the Property will not cut off all access to adjoining
5 properties and will not affect any public service easement.

6 (c) The Property has been closed and impassable for vehicular travel, and no
7 public funds have been expended on its maintenance as such for the last five years.

8 Section 3: The proposed summary street vacation project is exempt from the provisions
 9 of the California Environmental Quality Act pursuant to Section 15061 (b) (3) of the Guidelines
 10 for Implementation of the California Environmental Quality Act (Title 15, California Code of
 11 Regulations, commencing with Section 15000) as it can be seen with certainty that there is no
 12 possibility that the activity will have a significant effect on the environment.

Section 4: The City Council hereby orders the Summary Vacation of approximately 13 2,044 square feet of alley located adjacent to Mission Inn Avenue, between Market Street and 14 the Main Street Pedestrian Mall, as particularly described and depicted in Exhibit "A", attached 15 hereto and incorporated herein by this reference, subject to the Recommended Conditions 16 contained in the Council Report, and further, reserving and excepting in place easements and 17 rights-of-way, if the same exist, from the vacation herein above ordered; and the right to 18 construct, maintain, operate, inspect, replace, remove, renew, repair and enlarge lines of pipe, 19 conduits, cables, wires, poles, vaults, manholes, markers, equipment, fixtures and other 20 convenient and appurtenant structures, for the distribution and/or transmission of electrical 21 energy, underground facilities including water pipelines, gas lines, storm drains, sanitary sewers, 22 telephone, telegraph, cable television and other communication facilities, as they currently exist. 23

Section 5: The City Clerk of the City of Riverside shall assign a deed number hereto and
cause a certified copy of this resolution to be recorded in the Office of the County Recorder of
Riverside County, California, of the alley described and depicted in Exhibit "A" shall be and is
hereby terminated as of the date of said recordation and shall no longer constitute a public alley
from and after said date of recordation.
