
# **RECOMMENDATION:**


# **BACKGROUND**:

The Riverside Public Library historically orders new library cards annually, with the exception of last year due to excess stock in supply. The library cards have been created with various designs and colors. Approximately 291,340 library cards have been issued.









# **DISCUSSION:**

In collaboration with the City's marketing team, the Library designed the new Library card below. Approximately 40,000 cards will be ordered and available in four different colors to choose from such as dark blue, dark red, green and golden. The cost of the cards is approximately \$3,600 with funding available in the Library's Department Supply Account. The new cards will be available in mid-June.
