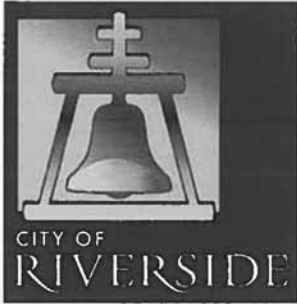

CITY ATTORNEY REPORT ON CLOSED SESSIONS


City Attorney Geuss announced there were no reportable actions on the closed sessions held earlier in the day.
