SUBJECT: WATER HIGHLIGHTS – July 2017

Domestic water production for the month of July 2017 totaled 7,218 acre-feet (2,352 million gallons), with the following resource mix:

Bunker Hill Basin: 69%Riverside Basin: 31%Purchased Water: 0%

Peak water usage for the month of July 2017, was 83 million gallons per day (mgd) and occurred on July 9th.


Under the Cooperative Agreement for Water Production and Conveyance with Western Municipal Water District, 722 AF of potable water and 267 AF of irrigation water were delivered to WMWD.

There were no significant events for the water system in July 2017.
