This letter serves to document the mutually agreed decision to terminate the MOU between the City of Riverside Parks, Recreation and Community Services Department and John Muir Charter Schools. As discussed between Mike Wegner, JMCS Southern Regional Director, and yourself, the vacancy created in the Job Developer position with the City of Riverside has changed the nature of the program and thus the need for an official partnership between JMCS and the City via an MOU. The current MOU will remain in effect until the end of the academic year on 6/30/2017.

While there will no longer be an official MOU beginning on 7/1/17, JMCS will continue to operate a dropout recovery program utilizing leased spaces from the City and will continue to refer students to receive services offered at the local YOCs, such as Project Bridge and other opportunities. We would appreciate the continued referral of eligible students who could benefit from our program and look forward to continuing to work together to positively impact the lives of the youth in Riverside.
