**SUBJECT: ACCEPT BOOK DONATION FROM INLANDIA INSTITUTE'S EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR CATI PORTER**

## **ISSUE:**

Accept book donation from Inlandia Institute's Executive Director Cati Porter.

## **RECOMMENDATION:**

That the Board of Library Trustees accept the book donation for addition to the Riverside Public Library collection.

## **BACKGROUND:**

On August 10, 2017, Director Kennon received notification from Cati Porter, Executive Director of Inlandia Institute (Inlandia) that Inlandia will donate new books to the Riverside Public Library's collection. Inlandia's core mission is ... "to support and expand all forms of literary activity through community programs in Inland Southern California." Some of the programs offered by Inlandia include creative literacy workshops for children and families, provide free public events, and partners with other agencies and organizations.

## **DISCUSSION:**

The four books to be donated are: 1) *While We're Here We Should Sing*; 2) *Go to the Living*; 3) *Traces of a Fifth Column*, and 4) *God's Will for Monsters*. The number of copies donated will be eight copies of each book title.
