TIME EXTENSION OF WATER CODE SECTION 13383 ORDER TO SUBMIT METHOD TO COMPLY WITH STATEWIDE TRASH PROVISIONS; REQUIREMENTS FOR PHASE I MUNICIPAL SEPARATE STORM SEWER SYSTEM (MS4) CO-PERMITTEES WITHIN THE JURISDICTION OF THE SANTA ANA REGIONAL WATER QUALITY CONTROL BOARD

Dear Mr. Martinez,

On June 2, 2017, I issued an Order, pursuant to California Water Code Section 13383, requesting that the City of Riverside (City) submit a report by August 31, 2017. In the report, the City is to select Track 1 or Track 2 according to the Statewide Trash Provisions. In a letter dated August 23, 2017, the City of Riverside requested a 90-day extension to report their selection. The extension would allow evaluation of the options by the City's Land Use Committee.

I hereby grant the City's request for additional time. The City's new deadline to report their selection is November 22, 2017. Should the City select Track 2, then the November 30, 2018 due date for submitting the required implementation plan remains in effect as indicated in the June 2, 2017 Order.
