RECITALS

WHEREAS, the City and Consultant entered into that certain Professional Consultant Services Agreement dated August 8, 2014 ("Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, the City and Consultant entered into a First Amendment to Professional Consultant Services Agreement ("First Amendment") dated June 21, 2017; and

WHEREAS, the term of the Agreement will expire on June 30, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the City has been satisfied with Consultant's performance under the Agreement and desires to have Consultant continue providing the services referenced in that Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the City and Consultant desire to increase the amount of compensation to One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000).

NOW, THEREFORE, incorporating the recitals set out above, the parties hereto mutually agree to the following amendment to the Agreement.

- 1. <u>Section 3</u>. Compensation of the Agreement is hereby amended to increase the compensation to an amount not to exceed One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000).
- 2. All other terms and conditions of the Agreement between the parties which are not inconsistent with the terms of this Second Amendment shall remain in full force and effect as if fully set forth herein.
