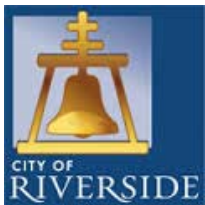

2. Shift focus away from individual silos to comprehensive regional approach.
3. Place 25% of people captured in point in time count in housing with appropriate wrap around services.

## RECOMMENDATIONS

That the City Council:

1. Approve the Beyond Framework Fund Program Funding Agreement Beyond Team Program Category Western Riverside Homeless Collaborative, with the Western Riverside Council of Governments, the City of Riverside, the City of Corona, the City of Jurupa Valley, the County of Riverside, and the Path of Five Ministries, to address homelessness through a regional approach, in the amount of \$79,000;
2. Authorize an increase in estimated revenues in the amount of \$79,000 and appropriate expenditures in the same amount in a project account to be established in the 223 Fund by Finance for the Western Riverside Homeless Collaborative, and
3. Authorize the City Manager, or his designee, to execute the Beyond Framework Fund Program Funding Agreement Beyond Team Program Category Western Riverside Homeless Collaborative, including making minor and non-substantive changes.
