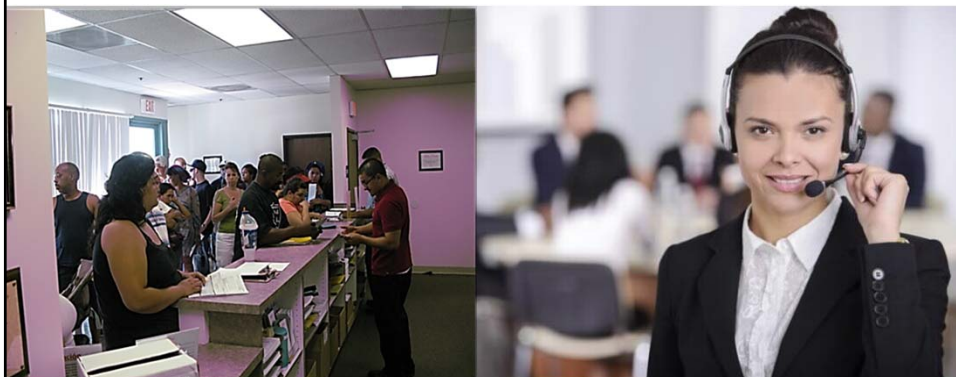

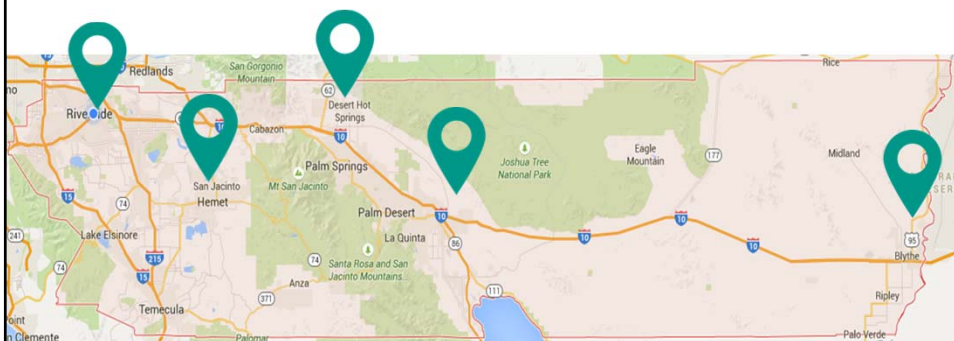


## Cool and Warm Centers

- 📍 Warm Centers are activated from December through April.

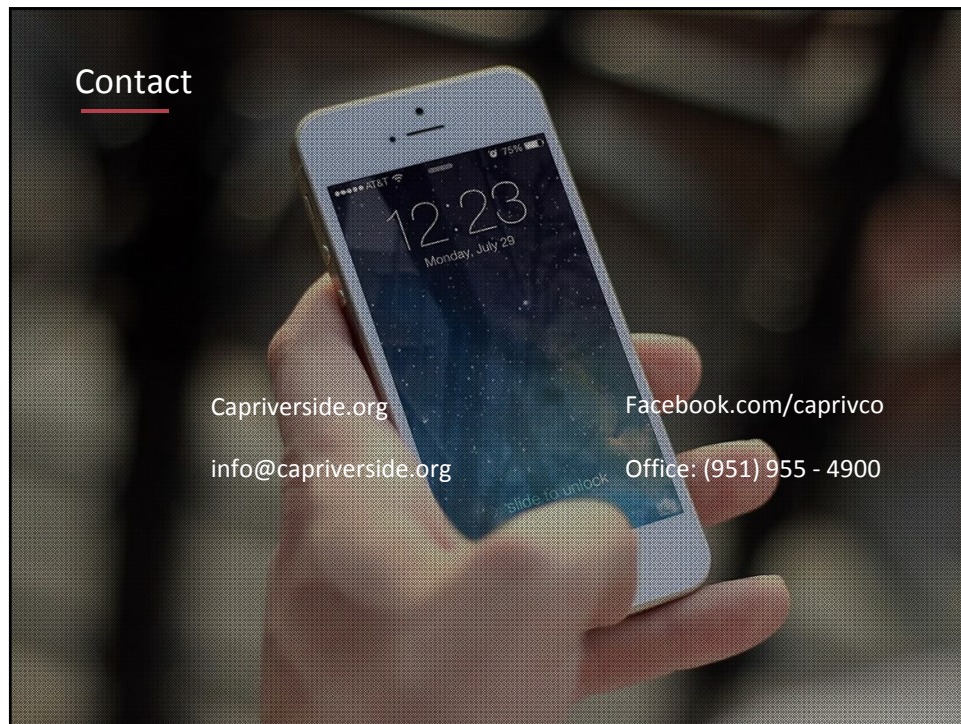
