SUBJECT: AWARD BID NO. 7360 FOR THE WIDENING OF ARLINGTON AVENUE FROM WESTERLY CITY LIMITS TO FAIRHAVEN DRIVE TO EBS GENERAL ENGINEERING, INC., IN THE AMOUNT OF \$718,858.00 – SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION

ISSUE:

Award a construction contract for Bid No. 7360 to widen Arlington Avenue, repave the existing pavement, install street lights, guardrails, and additional striping from the Westerly City Limits to Fairhaven Drive to EBS General Engineering, Inc., of Corona, California, in the amount of \$718,858.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

That the City Council:

1. Award a construction contract for Bid No. 7360 – Arlington Avenue widening from Westerly City Limits to Fairhaven Drive to EBS General Engineering, Inc., of Corona, California, in the amount of \$718,858; and
2. Authorize the City Manager, or his designee, to execute the construction contract with EBS General Engineering, Inc., including making minor non-substantial changes.
3. Authorize a supplemental appropriation in the amount of \$668,000 in Highway Safety Improvement Program funds to Arlington-Fairhaven/City Limit account number 9872328-440125, and increase the estimated revenue by the same amount in Arlington-Fairhaven/City Limit - Federal Surface Transportation Program account number 9872328-331310.

DISCUSSION:

The Arlington Avenue widening project will construct improvements on Arlington Avenue from the Westerly City Limits to Fairhaven Drive. The Project will:

1. Widen the roadway by paving the existing dirt shoulders;
2. Provide a 2-inch asphalt concrete cap over the existing roadway pavement;
3. Install guardrails at the roadway curves;

4. Provide striping to add left and right turn pockets to Hidden Valley Wildlife Area and Crestlawn Memorial Park; and
5. Install additional street lights within the project limits.

On October 3, 2017, eight bids were received for the construction of the Project. The lowest responsive bid was from EBS General Engineering, Inc., in the amount of \$718,858.00, which is 14% under the Engineer's Estimate.

The Purchasing Manager concurs with the award recommendation.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The estimated total Project cost including design, construction, construction engineering, and contingencies is \$940,000. With the appropriation of grant funds, sufficient funds are available in accounts 9872330-440313 (Arlington-Fairhaven/City Limit – Measure A) and 9872328-440125 (Arlington-Fairhaven/City Limit – Federal Surface Transportation Program) to award the contract and complete the Project.
