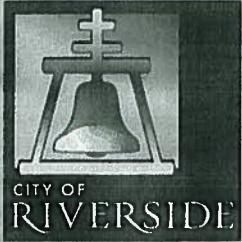

Re: Revocation of Massage Establishment Permit for Ivy Massage Spa

Dear Ms. Li,

On November 8, 2017, Captain Frank Assumma provided you with a written notice reference an incident that occurred at your business, Ivy Massage Spa, on August 8, 2017. The details of the incident concerned prohibited conduct being conducted inside your business. As a result of the allegations that your business failed to act in a manner that comports with the peace, health, safety, convenience, good morals, and general welfare of the general public, a recommendation was made that the Massage Establishment Permit for Ivy Massage Spa be revoked. This prompted you to exercise your right to appeal and schedule a hearing with the Riverside Police Department's Deputy Chief of Operations prior to the revocation of the Massage Establishment Permit.

On November 30, 2017, the Deputy Chief of Operations conducted a hearing to determine if you had any evidence to refute the factual allegations that lead to the proposed revocation. After careful review of the information and exhibits you provided, it was determined that there was no evidence that refuted the allegation of prohibited conduct, and sufficient grounds existed to uphold the revocation of the permit. As such, the revocation of your Massage Establishment Permit for Ivy Massage Spa is upheld.

You have the right to appeal this decision to the City Council's Public Safety Committee by notifying the City Clerk within ten (10) calendar days after receiving this correspondence pursuant to RMC 5.52.140. However, Ivy Massage Spa must remain closed until the appeal is heard by the Public Safety Committee and a decision is made on whether or not to uphold the revocation of your Massage Establishment Permit.
