SUBJECT: UPDATE ON A CITY ARCHIVE IN THE NEW MAIN LIBRARY

ISSUE:

Receive an update on the City Archive in the new Main Library.

RECOMMENDATION:

That the Board of Library Trustees receive an update on the City Archive in the new Main Library.

BACKGROUND:

The City Council approved construction of the new Main Library on October 3, 2017, and directed staff to return within 90 days with a funding proposal to also construct a City Archive in the new Main Library.

DISCUSSION:

On December 19, 2017, the City Council approved amending the Measure Z 5-year spending plan and authorized the allocation of \$2,000,000 in Measure Z contingency funds and \$1,300,000 of the Measure Z allocation for the Riverside Metropolitan Museum, for a total of \$3,300,000, to construct a City Archive in the new Main Library. The cost to construct a City Archive is separate from the \$40 million cost to construct the new Main Library at 3911 University Avenue.

FISCAL IMPACT:

There is no fiscal impact associated with this update.
