REQUEST FOR FIVE-TON WEIGHT LIMIT ON LOCHMOOR DRIVE AND FAIR

**ISLE DRIVE** 

# ISSUE:

City Council is being asked to establish a 5-ton weight limit on Lochmoor Drive and Fair Isle Drive.

# **RECOMMENDATIONS:**

Staff recommends that the City Council Introduce an ordinance to establish a five-ton weight limit on Lochmoor Drive and Fair Isle Drive.

# **BACKGROUND:**

Staff received a request from the Sycamore Highlands Community Action Group, requesting the City to establish a 5-ton weight limit on Lochmoor Drive and Fair Isle Drive.

Large commercial trucks are using these streets as a route to transport goods to and from the Sycamore Canyon Business Park, bypassing the arterial streets of Sycamore Canyon Boulevard and Central Avenue near the 60/215 Freeway. Lochmoor and Fair Isle are residential in nature with homes backing and siding onto these streets. They have one lane in each direction and a curvilinear alignment. Lochmoor and Fair Isle are intended to serve as internal collector streets for the residential neighborhood and not as a truck route.

Notices were mailed to the property owners and residents informing them that the Parking, Traffic and Streets Commission would be considering their request. On October 5, 2005, the Commission recommended that a 5-ton weight limit on Lochmoor Drive and Fair Isle Drive be established.

# FISCAL IMPACT:

The cost to post signs will be minimal.

# **ALTERNATIVES:**

The City Council could elect not to approve the five-ton weight limit.

The minutes of September 7, 2005 were modified to show that Commissioner Krieger was not present at the meeting. (MS, Mease, Krieger, 7 ayes)


# 1. File No. 05-27: Five-Ton Weight Limit Request on Lochmoor Drive and Fair Isle Drive

Patricia Castillo, Senior Engineer presented the staff report. 1 resident spoke in favor of the five-ton weight restriction stating that trucks using the streets to bypass Sycamore Canyon and Central were creating constant stopping and starting noise. There was no one from the public to speak against the weight limit restriction. Discussion followed.

A motion was made to recommend the five-ton weight limit restriction on Lochmoor Drive and Fair Isle Drive. (MS, Krieger, Waldo, all ayes)

2. File No. 05-28: Speed Hump Request on Shamrock Avenue
Patricia Castillo, Senior Engineer presented the staff report. 6 residents
spoke in favor of the speed hump installation, citing increased traffic,
vehicles speeding, lack of sidewalk on one side of the street, and school
traffic. There was no one from the public to speak against the speed hump
installation. Discussion followed.

A motion was made to recommend installation of 3 speed humps on Shamrock Avenue between Fairmount Boulevard and Main Street. (MS, Krieger, Sandler, all ayes)



# ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, AMENDING SECTION 10.56.010 OF THE RIVERSIDE MUNICIPAL CODE DESIGNATING THE RESTRICTION OF CERTAIN VEHICLES FOR STREETS AND PORTIONS THEREOF TO ESTABLISH A FIVE TON WEIGHT LIMIT ON LOCHMOOR DRIVE AND FAIR ISLE DRIVE.

The City Council of the City of Riverside, California, does ordain as follows:

Section 1: Section 10.56.010 of the Riverside Municipal Code, establishing restrictions on certain City streets or portions thereof, is hereby amended in its entirety in order to establish a Five Ton Weight Limit on Lochmoor Drive and Fair Isle Drive to read as follows:

"When signs are erected giving notice thereof, no person shall operate any commercial vehicle exceeding the gross weight as hereinafter designated at any time upon any of the streets or parts of streets listed below, except that such vehicle may be operated thereon for the purpose of delivering or picking up materials or merchandise or the performance of services in connection with and in aid of a property in the block, and then only be entering such street at the intersection nearest the destination of the vehicle and proceeding thereon no farther than the nearest intersection thereafter, and except as provided in Section 10.56.030:
