
















Community Based Clinics

Partners in Public Health


Riverside County Health Coalition: Brings together various community partners to strategize on the best methods to combat health-related challenges facing the city and county.

Safe Routes to School: Public Health officials work with Riverside city and school representatives to promote healthier lifestyles around walking and riding, culminating in October with the International Walk to School Day.

Teen Suicide Awareness and Prevention: Public Health officials work with local representatives to provide students with information and education on teen suicide and how to prevent the tragedy.

Safety Chaperone Program: Operated through the Eastside Reconciliation Coalition, Public Health works with school and city officials to promote the Safety Chaperone Program that uses volunteers to help walk children to school in crime-plagued areas.





Crisis Stabilization Unit Mental Health Urgent Care

- The Riverside MHUC has seen approx. 5000 consumers since December 2015
- Average length of stay Riverside 12hrs.
- Re-admission to MHUC within 30 days 7.5% combined sites
- Consumers sent to a Hospital <2.5%
- Consumer Satisfaction Scores 95%+




Behavioral Health Crisis Support System of Care


- Crisis Call Center available 7 days a week 12:00 noon – 10:00pm (excluding County holidays)
- 24/7 Mental Health Urgent Care Services
- Screening, assessment, crisis counseling, peer navigation and support, wellness planning, linkage to services, and psychiatric medications in a safe setting.



Community Response Evaluation and Support Team (C.R.E.S.T.)

- Program Description
 - Fully mobile field based crisis response teams
 - Accessible by and for law enforcement
 - Teams consist of Clinical Therapists or Behavioral Health Specialists, and Peer Support Specialists
 - Teams are equipped with a car, laptops, cell phones and a mobile printer
 - Teams work collaboratively with law enforcement to support individuals experiencing a crisis
- Program Goals
 - To support individuals in a mental health crisis immediate crisis and intervention support
 - Reduce the burden on law enforcement
 - Reduce hospital emergency room and inpatient utilization
 - Reduce the number of unnecessary 5150's

- The RPD Police Liaison Team has been very successful and the officer and clinical therapist have earned accommodations for their positive actions in the community.
- Police liaison assigned to RPD has responded with an officer to 1100 mental health calls since May 2015
