BACKGROUND

- 1. The State Trash Amendments require the City to fully capture trash from Priority Land Uses
- 2. On October 24th, the City Council selected Track 2 as the City's method to comply with the State Trash Amendments and staff committed to provide updates to this committee on actions taken to comply with the requirements of Track 2






IMPLEMENTATION PLAN

- 1. Track 2 requires submission of an Implementation Plan to the Regional Water Board by November 30, 2018
- 2. Implementation Plan will describe:
 - a) Final Priority Land Use areas
 - b) Combination of full capture controls selected
 - c) How trash levels will be assessed
 - d) How Full Capture System Equivalency will be demonstrated


















WHY LITTER?

- Convenience and availability of trash receptacles
 The more available and convenient the trash receptacle, the less likely individuals are to litter
- 2. Presence of litter

The more litter found in a certain area, the more likely individuals are to litter in those areas

3. Role of societal norms

Anti-litter social norms will cause changes in individual behavior of litterers
