

1 RESOLUTION NO.

2 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE,
3 CALIFORNIA, AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 22451 KNOWN AS THE
4 MASTER PARKING SCHEDULE RESOLUTION TO REVISE THE
5 PREFERENTIAL PARKING ZONE ON CLARKSDALE DRIVE.

6 WHEREAS, the Public Works Department received a petition from 100% of residents on
7 Clarksdale Drive from Lyon Avenue to the northerly cul-de-sac requesting revision of the existing
8 1-Hour Preferential Parking Zone (“PPZ”) to change the duration to “7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.
9 except Saturday, Sunday, and holidays” to extend the restriction later into the evening; and

10 WHEREAS, residents indicate that the existing duration of the PPZ no longer meets their
11 needs, as overflow parking from students attending nearby North-West College has now extended
12 later into the evenings impacting the availability of on-street parking for residents until 8:00 p.m.
13 weekdays; and

14 WHEREAS, the proposed revision would enhance the effectiveness of the PPZ for
15 residents by helping to better preserve on-street parking for residents and their guests during
16 evening hours; and

17 WHEREAS, on December 6, 2017, the Transportation Board unanimously recommended
18 the revision of the duration of the existing Preferential Parking Zone on both sides of Clarksdale
19 Drive from Lyon Avenue to the northerly cul-de-sac.

20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Riverside,
21 California, as follows:

22 Section 1: The recitals set forth above are incorporated herein by reference.

23 Section 2: That the Master Parking Schedule is hereby amended by revising the existing
24 Preferential Parking Zone on both sides of Clarksdale Drive from Lyon Avenue to the northerly
25 cul-de-sac to change the duration from “1-Hour Parking between the hours of 7:00 a.m. to 5:00
26 p.m. except Saturday, Sunday and holidays” to “1-Hour Parking between the hours of 7:00 a.m. to
27 8:00 p.m. except Saturday, Sunday and holidays.”

Section 3: That the provisions of this resolution shall be operative only when signs are erected on that portion of the street set forth in Section 2 above, giving notice of the parking limitations or prohibitions herein established.

Section 4: The provisions of this amendment shall be operative as of the date of adoption of this resolution.
