

1 RESOLUTION NO.

2 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE,
3 CALIFORNIA, AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 22451 KNOWN AS THE
4 MASTER PARKING SCHEDULE RESOLUTION TO REVISE THE 2-HOUR
5 PARKING ZONE ON MAIN STREET.

6 WHEREAS, the Public Works Department received a request from the property owner of
7 Judy's Tax Service located at 2605/2609 Main Street to extend the existing 2-Hour Parking Zone
8 on the west side of Main Street north of Poplar Street to include the adjacent property which she
9 also owns located immediately north at 2581/2585/2589/2591 Main Street to provide additional
10 short-term parking for business patrons for both properties during peak business hours; and

11 WHEREAS, on June 23, 2015, the City Council approved the removal of a portion of the
12 2-Hour Parking Zone along the west side of Main Street leaving the segment from 310' north of
13 Poplar Street to Poplar Street including 2605/2609 Main Street in place; and

14 WHEREAS, per the property owner, her intent was to maintain the 2-Hour Parking Zone
15 at the front of both of her commercial properties to provide needed short-term parking for the
16 businesses operating at both properties; and

17 WHEREAS, as the property located at 2581/2585/2589/2591 Main Street is a separate
18 parcel from that occupied by Judy's Tax Service, it was not included in the revision of the 2-Hour
19 Parking Zone completed in 2015; and

20 WHEREAS, to rectify the prior oversight, the Public Works Department issued a work
21 order to install an additional 2-Hour Parking restriction sign with "Begin" plaque at the northerly
22 property line of 2581/2585/2589/2591 Main Street to discourage long-term parking and provide
23 short-term parking opportunities in the interim while the formal revision of the zone boundaries is
24 undergoing the adoption process; and

25 WHEREAS, on December 6, 2017, the Transportation Board approved staff's
26 recommendation to revise the existing 2-Hour Parking Zone on the west side of Main Street north
27 of Poplar Street to extend the northerly zone boundary 70 feet northerly.

28 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Riverside,
California, as follows:

1 Section 1: The recitals set forth above are incorporated herein by reference.

2 Section 2: That the Master Parking Schedule is hereby amended by revising the existing
3 “2-Hour Parking between the hours of 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. except Sunday and holidays” zone
4 on the west side of Main Street from “310 feet north of Poplar Street to Poplar Street” to “380 feet
5 north of Poplar Street to Poplar Street” to extend the zone 70’ northerly.

6 Section 3: That the provisions of this resolution shall be operative only when signs are
7 erected on that portion of the street set forth in Section 2 above, giving notice of the parking
8 limitations or prohibitions herein established.

9 Section 4: The provisions of this amendment shall be operative as of the date of adoption
10 of this resolution.
