SUBJECT: NOMINATING COMMITTEE UPDATE

ISSUES:

Receive Nominating Committee report for proposed Museum Board Chair and Vice-Chair for 2018.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

That the Museum Board:

- 1. Receive the report with nominations for Chair and Vice-Chair; and
- 2. Schedule the election of officers for Chair and Vice-Chair at the March 14, 2018 Museum Board meeting.

BACKGROUND:

Each year, the Museum Board designates a Nominating Committee. The Nominating Committee is tasked with providing nominations for Museum Board Chair and Vice-Chair to the full board no later than the regular February meeting. The election of officers is to be conducted annually during the board meeting in March, from the slate proposed by the Nominating Committee or from nominations from the floor. All officers shall be elected by the members for a term of one year. A member may serve no more than two successive years in the same office. Terms begin March 1st or when the motion is held. Below is a list of Board members who held the Chair and Vice Chair positions in previous years.
