SUBJECT: SHAREHOLDER PROXY AUTHORITY FOR MUTUAL WATER COMPANIES

ISSUE:

Delegate shareholder proxy authority for the City's shares for mutual water companies as outlined in this report.

RECOMMENDATION:

That the City Council approve and confirm the voting representatives and alternates outlined in the report and delegate authority to any designated representative or alternate to vote the City's shares as the City's proxy at all meetings of the respective mutual water companies.

BOARD RECOMMENDATION:
