3	RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 21052 TO AMEND THE MASTER FRINGE BENEFITS AND
4	SALARY PLAN FOR SALARY ADJUSTMENTS FOR EXISTING SAFETY OFFICER, LIFEGUARD/INSTRUCTOR, POOL
5	MANAGER, AND ASSISTANT AQUATICS COORDINATOR CLASSIFICATIONS, CREATE A NEW CLASSIFICATION AND
6	SALARY RANGE FOR THE SAFETY SPECIALIST POSITION, AND REVISE THE BARGAINING UNIT DESIGNATION FOR
7	THE FIRE COMMUNITY PREPAREDNESS INSTRUCTOR.
8	WHEREAS, on October 4, 2005, Resolution No. 21052 was adopted by the City Council
9	thereby adopting the Master Fringe Benefits and Salary Plan ("FBSP"); and
10	WHEREAS, the FBSP includes the fringe benefits and salary plans for City employees;
11	and
12	WHEREAS, the FBSP has been amended several times to update the benefits and
13	salaries; and
14	WHEREAS, the Job Code Table of the FBSP needs to be revised to reflect the salary
15	range changes that have been proposed for the existing Safety Officer, Lifeguard/Instructor, Pool
16	Manager, and Assistant Aquatics Coordinator; and WHEREAS, the Job Code Table of the FBSP needs to be revised to reflect the creation of
17	the classification and salary range that has been proposed for the Safety Specialist classification;
18	and
19	WHEREAS, the Job Code Table of the FBSP needs to be revised to reflect the change in
20	bargaining unit designation for the classification of Fire Community Preparedness Instructor and
21	including a salary adjustment to reflect the 4% Cost of Living granted to the Para-Professional
22	unit, effective January 1, 2018.
23	NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Riverside, as
24	follows:
25	Section 1: Resolution No. 21052 and the Master Fringe Benefits and Salary Plan are
26	hereby amended to 1) adjust the salary ranges for the existing Safety Officer,
27	Lifeguard/Instructor, Pool Manager, and Assistant Aquatics Coordinator classifications; 2) create
28	

the classification and salary range for the Safety Specialist classification; and 3) change the bargaining unit designation for the classification of Fire Community Preparedness Instructor from Special Classes Unit to Para-Professional, including a salary adjustment to reflect the 4% Cost of Living granted to the Para-Professional unit effective January 1, 2018, as set forth in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference. 

Authorize the City Manager, or his designee, to make minor, non-Section 2: substantive changes to the Master Fringe Benefits and Salary Plan and any related policies, procedures or documents necessary to implement these provisions. 

The provisions of this resolution shall be operative upon adoption. Section 3:
