ISSUE:

Approve acceptance of 470 entrance passes valued at \$78,490 donated to the Fire Department by Disneyland Resorts.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

That the City Council approve the acceptance of 470 entrance passes valued at \$78,490 donated to the Fire Department by Disneyland Resorts.

DISCUSSION:

As a token of its appreciation for the fire service, Disneyland Resorts has generously donated 470 entrance passes, valued at \$78,490 to the City of Riverside Fire Department. Per Administration Manual Policy 06.011.00 Minor Donation Acceptance Policy, donations of cash or items valued at more than \$25,000 must be accepted by the City Council.

If accepted by the City Council, the Fire Department will distribute two passes to each fire department member, one for the employee and one for the employee's guest.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The 470 Disneyland Resorts passes are valued at \$78,490. No goods or services were provided by the City in exchange for this donation.
