**SUBJECT: CITY ATTORNEY'S OFFICE (CAO) – CONFLICTS OF INTEREST AND ETHICS PRESENTATION**

**ISSUE:**

Receive oral presentation from the City Attorney's Office on Conflicts of Interest and Ethics.

**RECOMMENDATION:**

That the Transportation Board receive the CAO presentation on Conflicts of Interest and Ethics.

**BACKGROUND:**

On an annual basis the CAO presents the Conflicts of Interest and Ethics guide to the Transportation board to benefit new members and serve as a refresher course to returning board members.

**DISCUSSION:**

The CAO will be presenting an oral presentation on Conflicts of Interest and Ethics. The Code adopts a set of core values that constitute guiding principles for the conduct of public officials and specific prohibited conduct. Complaints may be filed for violations of the prohibited conduct only. Further, the Code sets forth hearing and appeal procedures, enforcement and sanction provisions, and monitoring and oversight requirements. The Code applies to the Mayor and members of the City Council at all times during their term of office as elected officials. The Code applies to members of boards, commissions, and committees only while they are acting in their official capacities or affecting the discharge of their duties.
