I write to inform the Ione Band of Miwok Indians of California that the Riverside Metropolitan Museum ("Museum") will move forward with their request to repatriate the human remains and associated funerary objects of Miwok origin from the RMM collections based upon the letter dated April 8, 2009 provided by Ione to the Museum wherein Ione provided a summary of their shared group identity and cultural affiliation, in relation to the human remains and associated funerary objects, sufficient to satisfy the preponderance of the evidence standard as required by NAGPRA.
