



Bid 7523 – 2017/2018 Arterial and Minor Streets Maintenance, Phase 1

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BACKGROUND

1. On October 18, 2011, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 22288 authorizing the submittal of an application to CalRecycle for a rubberized pavement grant;
2. On December 6, 2016, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 23120 amending Resolution No. 22288 to extend the expiration date for the Rubberized Pavement Grant Program to June 30, 2021; and
3. On July 25, 2017, the City and CalRecycle entered into a \$70,000 Grant Agreement.

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BACKGROUND (CONT)

On June 28, 2016, the City Council approved a cooperative agreement with the Riverside County Flood Control and Water Conservation District (RCFC&WCD) to replace the Monroe open channel between Magnolia Avenue and California Avenue, and to authorize a supplement appropriation in the amount of \$56,500 in District funds to compensate the City for relocating existing street lights (\$14,500), deactivate and reactivate existing irrigation water meters (\$3,000), and repaving portions of the street impacted by channel replacement work (\$39,000).



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CURRENT PROJECT


1. Repave Monroe Street from Magnolia Avenue to California Avenue (0.52 miles);
2. Install new planting and drip-irrigation system on each side of the newly completed underground storm drain facility as well as a decorative walking path over the channel;
3. Repave Pierce Street from Sierra Vista Avenue to La Sierra Avenue (0.71 miles);
4. Repave 1.02 miles of Minor Streets in the residential neighborhood east of Monroe Street;
5. Reconstruct damaged concrete curbs, gutters, sidewalks, driveways, and pedestrian ramps;
6. Reconstruct damaged traffic signal loops on Arlington Avenue and Rutland Avenue; and
7. Install signing and striping.



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COMPETITIVE BIDS

1. February 20, 2018 – Four bids were received for construction.
2. Lowest responsive bid was from EBS General Engineering, Inc., of Corona, California.
3. Bid amount: \$2,376,001 (7.4% below estimate).

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RECOMMENDATIONS

That the City Council:

1. Award a construction contract for Bid No. 7523 for 2017/2018 Arterial and Minor Streets Maintenance, Phase 1 to EBS General Engineering, Inc., of Corona, California, in the amount of \$2,376,001;
2. Authorize a supplemental appropriation in the amount of \$70,000 in CalRecycle rubberized pavement grant to project account number 9904429-440229 (Rubberized Pavement FY 16/17) and increase the estimated revenue by the same amount in project account 9904429-335350; and
3. Authorize the City Manager, or his designee, to execute the construction contract with EBS General Engineering, Inc., including making minor non-substantial changes.

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
