A RESOLUTION OF THE OVERSIGHT BOARD FOR CITY OF RIVERSIDE AS SUCCESSOR AGENCY TO THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE AND INSTALLATION OF SIX (6) NEW UMBRELLAS FOR THE CALIFORNIA TOWER COMMERCIAL BUILDING LOCATED AT 3737 MAIN STREET.

WHEREAS, on January 10, 2012, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 22322 re-affirming the authorization of the City of Riverside to become Successor Agency to the Redevelopment Agency

WHEREAS, subsequent legislation entitled "Assembly Bill 1484", signed into law on June 27, 2012, makes substantive amendments to ABx1 26 and specifically includes a requirement, set forth at Health & Safety Code section 34179(e), that all actions taken by the oversight board be adopted by resolution; and

WHEREAS, the Successor Agency owns the property located at 3737 Main Street, commonly known as California Tower ("Cal Tower"), and is responsible for paying for all maintenance and repairs needed to maintain the overall attractiveness of the Ground Floor of Cal Tower as well as the food court area; and

WHEREAS, Inland Pacific Advisors ("IPA") is the property manager for Cal Tower and is responsible for providing the management for all maintenance and repair projects for Cal Tower; and

WHEREAS, the existing umbrellas, located on the Main Street Pedestrian Mall, and which serve Cal Tower guests and food court patrons, are damaged and need to be replaced; and

WHEREAS, on October 4, 2018, IPA issued a Request for Proposals to solicit bids for the replacement of six (6) new umbrellas along the Main Street Pedestrian Mall; and

WHEREAS, the most responsive bid was received from USA Shade and Fabric in the amount of \$82,580; and

WHEREAS, IPA shall perform the project management services for a fee of \$4,129 and USA Shade and Fabric will fabricate and install the new umbrellas for an amount not to exceed \$82,580; and

1	WHEREAS, staff recommends the Successor Agency approve the purchase and installation of
2	six (6) new umbrellas and management of the installation for a total amount of \$86,709.
3	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Oversight Board for the City of Riverside as
4	the Successor Agency to the Redevelopment Agency of the City of Riverside, as follows:
5	Section 1: Pursuant to Health & Safety Code section 34181 (e), the Oversight Board for the
6	City of Riverside as the Successor Agency to the Redevelopment Agency of the City of Riverside does
7	hereby approve the purchase and installation of six (6) new umbrellas and the management of the
8	installation for a total amount of \$86,709, for the California Tower building located at 3737 Main
9	Street.
10	Section 2: Authorizes the City Manager or his designee, on behalf of the Successor Agency to
11	execute the all related documents to complete the purchase and installation of the umbrellas.
