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## RESOLUTION NO.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, ALL NECESSARY APPLICATIONS, CONTRACTS, PAYMENT REQUESTS, AGREEMENTS AND AMENDMENTS IN THE PROCESS OF APPLYING FOR AND SECURING FUNDS UNDER THE DEPARTMENT OF RESOURCES RECYCLING AND RECOVERY (CALRECYCLE) HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE GRANT PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Public Resources Code sections 48000 et seq., the Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery ("CalRecycle") is authorized to administer various grant programs in furtherance of the State of California's efforts to reduce, recycle and reuse solid waste generated in the state thereby preserving landfill capacity and protecting public health and safety and the environment, including but not limited to the Household Hazardous Waste Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, CalRecycle's Household Hazardous Waste Grant Program application procedures require an applicant's governing body to declare by resolution certain authorizations related to the program administration; and

WHEREAS, the City of Riverside ("City") desires to establish a Household Hazardous Waste Grant Program in accordance with CalRecycle's Household Hazardous Waste Program; and

WHEREAS, the City, as an applicant, must enter into an agreement with the State of California for the establishment, implementation and maintenance of a Household Hazardous Waste Grant Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Riverside, California, as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>: The City Council of the City of Riverside does hereby authorize application to CalRecycle for a Household Hazardous Waste Grant Program grant.

Section 2: The City Manager, or its designee, is hereby authorized and empowered to execute on behalf of the City all necessary documents, including but not limited to, applications, payment requests, agreements and amendments thereto, necessary to secure grant funds and to implement the approved grant project.

<u>Section 3</u>. The authority granted herein shall be valid for five (5) years from the date of the adoption of this Resolution.
