SUBJECT: PUBLIC HEARING — FREEWAY MAINTENANCE AGREEMENT WITH THE

STATE OF CALIFORNIA FOR STATE ROUTE 91 FROM BUCHANAN STREET

TO ROUTE 60/91/215 INTERCHANGE

ISSUES:

Conduct a public hearing regarding the approval of the Freeway Maintenance Agreement for the State Route 91 from Buchanan Street to Route 60/91/215 Interchange and adopt a resolution authorizing the Mayor to execute the Freeway Agreement.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

That the City Council:

- 1. Approve the Freeway Maintenance Agreement with the State of California for the State Route 91 between Buchanan Street and the 60/91/215 Interchange; and
- 2. Adopt a resolution authorizing the Mayor to execute the Freeway Agreement.

BACKGROUND:

On July 13, 2010, the City Council held a public hearing to consider a Freeway Agreement for State Route (SR) 91 High Occupancy Vehicle (HOV) Lane project and approved the Freeway Agreement with the State of California for the SR91 HOV Lane project between Adams Street and the 60/91/215 Interchange.

DISCUSSION:

The State of California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) is requesting the City to approve a new Freeway Agreement (attachment 1). The new agreement includes a map updating the freeway limits in the City, and supersedes all the previous agreements and/or supplemental agreements between the City and the State of California. Section 100.22 of the Streets and Highway Code requires the City to conduct a public hearing prior to entering into a Freeway Agreement. Additionally, Caltrans requires the City to adopt a resolution (attachment 2) including a statement that the public hearing Provisions in Section 100.22 of the Streets and Highway Code have been complied with and authorizing the Mayor to execute the Freeway Agreement.

FISCAL IMPACT:

There is no fiscal impact associated with the approval of the Freeway Maintenance Agreement.
