SUBJECT: AGRICULTURAL WATER RATES TASK FORCE MEMBER INTRODUCTIONS

ISSUE:

Introductions of the Agricultural Water Rates Task Force members and City staff.

RECOMMENDATION:

BACKGROUND:

On March 29, 2018 the Board of Public Utilities (Board) established an Agricultural Water Rates Task Force (Task Force), per City Council direction.
