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ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, AMENDING SECTION 10.56.050 OF THE RIVERSIDE MUNICIPAL CODE TO ESTABLISH AXLE RESTRICTIONS ON SEGMENTS OF ALESSANDRO BOULEVARD, ARLINGTON, CENTRAL, CHICAGO, IOWA, AND JURUPA AVENUES.

The City Council of the City of Riverside does ordain as follows:

Section 1: Section 10.56.050 of the Riverside Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 10.56.050 Commercial vehicles exceeding three (3) axles prohibited from using certain streets.

When signs are erected giving notice thereof, no person shall operate any commercial vehicle exceeding three (3) axles at any time upon any of the streets or parts of streets listed below, except that such vehicle may be operated thereon for the purpose of delivering or picking up materials or merchandise or the performance of services in connection with and in aid of a property in the block, and then only by entering such street at the intersection nearest the destination of the vehicle and proceeding thereon no farther than the nearest intersection thereafter:

Section 2: The City Council has reviewed the matter and, based upon the facts and information contained in the staff reports, administrative record, and written and oral testimony, hereby finds that this ordinance is not subject to CEQA pursuant to Sections 15060(c)(2), 15060(c)(3) and/or 15061(b)(3) of the State CEQA Guidelines, California Code of Regulations, Title 14, chapter 3, in that it will not result in a direct or reasonably foreseeable indirect physical change in the environment nor have a significant impact on the environment. Furthermore, pursuant to Section 15301(c), it is exempt from further review as an operation, repair, maintenance, permitting, leasing, licensing, or minor alteration of an existing public street.

Section 3: The City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this ordinance and cause publication once in a newspaper of general circulation in accordance with Section 414 of the Charter of the City of Riverside. This ordinance shall become effective on the 30th day after the date of its adoption.
