BID DESCRIPTION: The project entails maintenance improvements on Minor streets and two Arterial Streets throughout the City of Riverside. The specific Arterial streets included in this project are Pierce Street (Indiana Avenue to Magnolia Avenue) and Box Springs Boulevard (Sycamore Canyon Boulevard to River Crest Drive). This project generally includes, but is not limited to, the reconstruction of asphalt pavement, ARAM, concrete sidewalks, driveways, pedestrian ramps, cross gutters, curbs, and gutters; adjustment of water meters boxes, water valve covers, and sewer, storm drain, and electric manholes; removal and replacement of traffic striping; and installation of signs. Improvements also include the installation of a HAWK signal on Arlington Avenue at the Regional Learning Center and installation of Traffic Signal at the Mission Inn Avenue and Pine Street intersection.
