Sample Container

It's unlawful to put medical sharps such as hypodermic needles, lancets, pen needles etc. into curbside collection recycle or trash containers.

Sharps must be sealed in a sharps disposal container or a hard-sided PLASTIC container such as a bleach or laundry detergent bottle with a secure lid.
