SUBJECT: WATER HIGHLIGHTS – APRIL 2018

Domestic water production for the month of April 2018 totaled 4,779 acre feet (AF) (1,557 million gallons), with the following resource mix:

Bunker Hill Basin: 73%Riverside Basin: 27%Purchased: 0%

Peak water usage was 75 million gallons per day (mgd) which occurred on April 23⁻ 2018.

Under the Cooperative Agreement for Water Production and Conveyance with Western Municipal Water District (WMWD), 748 AF of potable water and 227 AF of irrigation water were delivered to WMWD.

There were no significant events for the water system in April 2018.
