# SUBJECT: CITY COUNCIL REGIONAL ORGANIZATION APPOINTMENT - RIVERSIDE NEIGHBORHOOD PARTNERSHIP

## ISSUE:

Recommend appointment of a member to the Riverside Neighborhood Partnership to the City Council.

#### **RECOMMENDATION:**

That the Committee recommend to the City Council appointment of a member to serve on the Riverside Neighborhood Partnership.

#### BACKGROUND:

The City Council Rules of Procedure and Order of Business, currently Resolution No. 23035, defines the number, names, composition, and appointment process for City Council Standing Committees and regional organization representation. The resolution provides that appointments to City Council Standing Committees and regional organization assignments shall be considered by the Mayor's Nominating and Screening Committee for recommendation to the City Council.

At the time the Riverside Neighborhood Partnership was established, the Councilmember appointed to serve on the RNP was liaison to the City Council Community Services and Youth Committee. Currently, the City Council Community Services and Youth Committee is comprised of Councilmembers Conder (Chair), Adams (Vice Chair), and Perry (Member). On September 18, 2017, the City Council appointed Councilmember Conder as the member and Councilmember Adams as the alternate on the Riverside Neighborhood Partnership (RNP).

On May 2, 2018, Tom Donahue, Chair of the RNP requested that the City Council reconsider the appointment, as Councilmember Conder is unable to attend the meetings due to a calendar conflict.
