ISSUE:

Designate a voting delegate and alternate to represent the City of Riverside at the League of California Cities 2018 annual business meeting on Friday, September 14, 2018.

RECOMMENDATION:

That the City Council designate Mayor Bailey as the voting delegate and Councilmember Perry as alternate for the business meeting of the 2018 League of California Cities annual conference.

DISCUSSION:

The League of California Cities (League) holds an annual conference and business meeting to take action on conference resolutions that guide cities and the League in efforts to improve the quality, responsiveness, and vitality of local government in California. The City of Riverside has the opportunity to appoint a voting delegate and alternate to represent the City of Riverside at the annual business meeting on Friday, September 14, 2018, in Long Beach.
