SUBJECT: WATER HIGHLIGHTS - MAY 2018

Domestic water production for the month of May 2018 totaled 5,192 acre feet (AF) (1,692 million gallons), with the following resource mix:

Bunker Hill Basin: 78%
Riverside Basin: 22%
Purchased: 0%

Peak water usage was 74 million gallons per day (mgd) which occurred on May 28, 2018.

Under the Cooperative Agreement for Water Production and Conveyance with Western Municipal Water District (WMWD), 778 AF of potable water and 57 AF of irrigation water were delivered to WMWD.

There were no significant events for the water system in May 2018.
