ISSUE:

Accept the donation of eight Fire Alexa Tablets valued at \$400 from Amazon.com.

RECOMMENDATION:

That the City Council accept the donation of eight Fire Alexa Tablets from Amazon.com.

BACKGROUND:

Zeshan Kazmi, of Amazon Strategic Communications, on behalf of Amazon.com, donated eight Fire Alexa Tablets to the Riverside Public Library to be used as prizes for the Teen Summer Reading Program.
