

1 RESOLUTION NO.

2 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF RIVERSIDE,
3 CALIFORNIA, DECLARING ITS INTENTION TO VACATE A
4 SEGMENT OF A PUBLIC ALLEY, CONNECTING FIFTH AND SIXTH
5 STREETS, BETWEEN MARKET STREET AND FAIRMOUNT
6 BOULEVARD.

7 BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Riverside, California, as follows:

8 Section 1: That the City Council of the City of Riverside hereby declares that in Planning
9 Case No. P17-0550, it is the intention of the City Council to vacate an approximately 220.62-foot
10 long by 20-foot wide segment of public alley connecting Fifth and Sixth Streets, between Market
11 Street and Fairmount Boulevard, totaling approximately 0.10 acres in area, within the City of
12 Riverside, California, for the reason that this portion of said street is unnecessary for present or
13 prospective public use.

14 Section 2: The City Council hereby elects and expresses its election to proceed in Planning
15 Case No. P17-0550 pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 3 of the Public Streets, Highways, and
16 Service Easements Vacation Law, commencing with Section 8320 of the Streets and Highways Code
17 of the State of California.

18 Section 3: The public alley proposed to be vacated in Planning Case No. P17-0550 is an
19 approximately 220.62-foot long by 20-foot wide segment of public alley connecting Fifth and Sixth
20 Streets, between Market Street and Fairmount Boulevard, totaling approximately 0.10 acres in area,
21 within the City of Riverside, California, as more particularly described and depicted in Exhibit "A"
22 attached hereto and incorporated by this reference.

23 Section 4: The date, hour, and place for hearing all persons interested in the proposed
24 vacation of the public street in Planning Case No. P17-0550 is set as August 14, 2018, at 3:00 p.m.
25 in the Council Chambers of the Riverside City Council located adjacent to City Hall, at 3900 Main
26 Street, Riverside, California.

27 Section 5: At the hearing provided for in Section 4 hereof, the City Council shall determine
28 whether this public street is unnecessary for present or prospective use, and if so, the reservations or
exceptions from the vacations that public convenience and necessity require, if any, which shall be
recited in the resolution of vacation as provided in Section 8341 of the Streets and Highways Code.

Section 6: Notices of the date, hour and place of the hearing of the proposed vacation shall be posted conspicuously along the public street proposed to be vacated at least two (2) weeks before the day set for the hearing. At least three (3) notices shall be posted not more than three (300) hundred feet apart. The notices shall state the day, hour, and place of hearing; shall refer to the adoption of this resolution of intention; and shall describe the public street proposed to be vacated.

Section 7: The City Clerk shall cause notice of the date, hour, and place of the hearing on this resolution of intention to be published for at least two (2) successive weeks prior to the hearing in The Press Enterprise.
