SUBJECT: CITY COUNCIL REGIONAL ORGANIZATION APPOINTMENT - RIVERSIDE

NEIGHBORHOOD PARTNERSHIP

ISSUE:

Appoint Councilmember Melendrez as member and Councilmember Adams as Alternate to the Riverside Neighborhood Partnership.

RECOMMENDATION:

The Mayor's Nominating and Screening Committee recommends that the City Council appoint Councilmember Melendrez as member and Councilmember Adams as Alternate to the Riverside Neighborhood Partnership to serve until reorganization of the City Council following the June and November 2019 City Council elections.

BACKGROUND:

The City Council Rules of Procedure and Order of Business, currently Resolution No. 23035, defines the number, names, composition, and appointment process for City Council Standing Committees and regional organization representation. The resolution provides that appointments to City Council Standing Committees and regional organization assignments shall be considered by the Mayor's Nominating and Screening Committee for recommendation to the City Council.

At the time the Riverside Neighborhood Partnership was established, the Councilmember appointed to serve on the RNP was liaison to the City Council Community Services and Youth Committee. Currently, the City Council Community Services and Youth Committee is comprised of Councilmembers Conder (Chair), Adams (Vice Chair), and Perry (Member). On September 18, 2017, the City Council appointed Councilmember Conder as the member and Councilmember Adams as the alternate on the Riverside Neighborhood Partnership (RNP).

On May 2, 2018, Tom Donahue, Chair of the RNP requested that the City Council reconsider the appointment, as Councilmember Conder is unable to attend the meetings due to a calendar conflict.

On June 12, 2018, the Mayor's Nominating and Screening Committee unanimously supported appointment of Councilmember Melendrez as member and Councilmember Adams as alternate

to the Riverside Neighborhood Partnership to serve until reorganization of the City Council following the June and November 2019 City Council elections.
