- 3. Utilized for projects considered standard/routine under \$500,000
- 4. Change in process; not a change in authority

- 2. Proposals received and evaluated
- 3. Consultant selected under Purchasing approval
- 4. Supplemental agreement prepared by CAO

How the panel will be used (cont'd):

- 5. Over \$50,000 Board Approval prior to Purchasing issuing P.O.
- 6. Under \$50,000 P.O. Issued by Purchasing

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#### RECOMMENDATIONS
