SUBJECT: SPC JESUS S. DURAN EASTSIDE LIBRARY SITE SELECTION UPDATE

ISSUE:

Receive a report on community outreach feedback for selecting a new site for the proposed SPC Jesus S. Duran Eastside Library.

RECOMMENDATION:

That the Board of Library Trustees receive an update on community outreach feedback for selecting a new site for the proposed SPC Jesus S. Duran Eastside Library.

BACKGROUND:

On April 23, 2018, the Board of Library Trustees agreed to consider the site of 2600 University Avenue for a new SPC Jesus S. Duran Eastside Library and decided to wait until after the Parks and Recreation Commission meeting on May 21, 2018 to vote on a recommended site.

DISCUSSION:

On June 25, 2018, the Board of Library Trustees received an update on the community meetings held and feedback received from the community. The community did not support the Bordwell site. Staff are currently looking at the Ottawa site and will collaborate with community members at future community meetings. During discussions, the Board of Library Trustees requested this item on every agenda to give Trustees and the community an opportunity to discuss and receive updates, as necessary.
